Big Numbers!

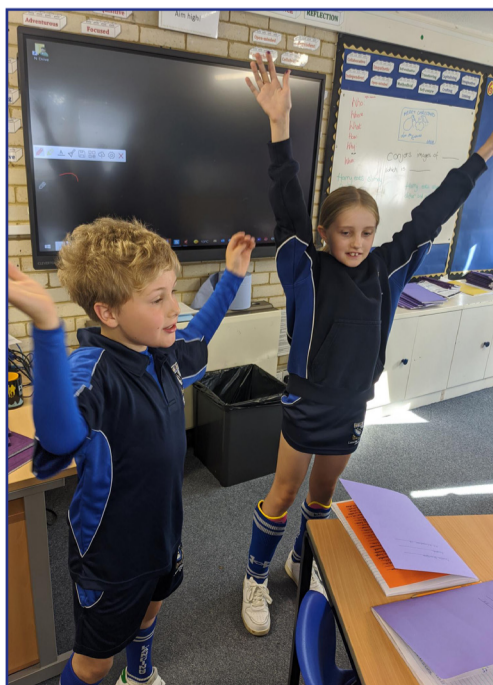
Year 5 and 6 have been looking at very **BIG** numbers and were asked the question 'How big is a million?'
